Chairperson Masterson presented Representative Sean Tarwater, Chairperson of the Unemployment Compensation Modernization and Improvement Council (UCMIC), who reviewed such Council's report to the Legislative Coordinating Council regarding a new information technology system for the Kansas Department of Labor. Chairperson Tarwater reviewed the report and indicated that the UCMIC had reviewed the information technology system, and technology and platform specifications pursuant to 2021 House Bill No. 2196 and made numerous recommendations for the LCC.
