The United States Postal Service increased postage for 1<sup>st</sup> class mail on 1 July 2022. In accordance with LCC Policy 38 franking allotments for legislators will increase as indicated below.

The USPS will be raising stamps for 1<sup>st</sup> class mail on 1 Jul 2022.
